Pastor's Point of View

"Give thanks to the Lord, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done. Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts. Glory in his name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice. Look to the Lord and his strength; seek his face always." 1 Chronicles 16:8-11

As we enter into the season of Thanksgiving, this verse from David's Psalm of Thanks came to mind.

Although we really don't need a special holiday to give thanks to God for the many things He has done for us, it is nice to have a national holiday set aside for the purpose of gathering as family and friends and giving thanks. Truly God has richly blessed our nation throughout our history, and it is right to give thanks to Him. I must confess that sometimes I fail to be as thankful to God as I should be.

Montreat, followed by a visit to see our son, Josh, in his new home in Charleston, SC and then have a relaxing time in Myrtle Beach, SC.

I am thankful for the trip, but also for a safe trip home and to return to a caring church family and to be surprised by a generous Pastor's Appreciation gift and hand-crafted pen!

I am thankful for the work that God is doing in our midst and His faithfulness. How thankful I am that God has brought Colby Ennis to our church family to minister to our children and youth, and to reach out to other young people in our community. I am looking forward to working with Rebecca Hodges, a talented musician, who will be joining with us as a keyboard accompanist. I am thankful for a successful Fall Festival that reached out into our community, and for the many volunteers who made it possible.

I have a lot to be thankful for! And I am thankful to be called by God to work among a hard-working, caring church family who are willing to use their gifts of time, talent and treasure in service to our Lord!


